We will develop collective action plans for the benefit of shared water resources and respective water catchment areas, ensuring alignment to existing catchment sustainability plans.

We will take the necessary steps within our authority to ensure that the Princes Gate site allocates resources to implement the Alliance Water Stewardship (AWS) Standard. We will ensure the site complies with all relevant legal and regulatory requirements. We will also ensure our employees on-site and the local community have adequate access to safe water for drinking, sanitation and hygiene.

Finally, we commit to reviewing and modifying not only our own site's water stewardship opportunities, but also, where relevant to advance good water governance in the local area and catchment. As well as disclosing relevant water related information with our stakeholders.
