### **Princes Gate Audit Announcement 2026**

Water is at the very foundation of what we do, and we're committed to protecting these precious resources for future generations. In Pembrokeshire, where our Nestlé Pure Life and Princes Gate bottling site is based, we are collaborating with local stakeholders and the community to address shared water challenges, encourage good practice and help regenerate the local water cycle.

Last year our site's commitment to water stewardship was recognised when the site achieved core status under the Alliance for Water Stewardship (AWS) International standard.

**From 31<sup>st</sup> March to the 2<sup>nd</sup> April 2026, we'll be undergoing our first surveillance audit, and our stakeholders and members of the public are invited to provide their comments before the audit and during the whole duration of the AWS certificate.
